Requirements for Acceptance

The **Order of the Sword and Shield** is open to any undergraduate, graduate, or certificate student who is enrolled in a **Homeland Security**, **Intelligence**, **Emergency Management**, or **Protective Security Studies** program. Please note that this is not a complete listing of all Protective Security disciplines and that the Society reserves the right to include/exclude any proposed academic program after careful review.

The following academic criteria **MUST** be satisfied at the time of induction:

- 1. Completion of **ONE HALF (1/2)** of the applicant's total number of credits required to earn the degree or certificate, including completion of **ONE HALF (1/2)** of all credits required by the Homeland Security, Intelligence, Emergency Management, or Protective Security Studies discipline; and
- 2. Have achieved an overall **3.25** (undergraduate) or a **3.50** (graduate) cumulative **GPA** or higher (on a scale of 4.0) for **ALL CREDITS**, including transfer credits; or be in the top 20% of such program; and
- 3. Provide **ONE (1)** academic letter of recommendation which **MUST** attest to the applicant's "outstanding academic performance" in his or her coursework; and
- 4. Provide an "unofficial" **transcript** or grade report.

The completed application package must be accompanied by a check or money order made payable to the **"Order of the Sword and Shield** in the amount of \$50.
